Goals

Phase 1 - Design

Pop Stalin Design (hereafter referred to as "PSD") will design and present at least 3 aesthetic designs for the website and 2 logo concept designs.

During this conceptual phase, PSD will, through research and client discussion, explore various means of incorporating the desired identity into both, the structural and aesthetic site designs.

Upon selection of one of the website aesthetic concepts, PSD will work with the client to refine and expand upon the chosen design.

To summarize, the design process will include:

1. Initial aesthetic design concepts
2. Revisions and evolution of 1 aesthetic design concept from round three
3. Final design revisions



Phase 2 - Website Development

Once the site design concept is approved, the site mark-up will begin. The site will be built using XHTML, CSS and, where applicable, JavaScript, following all web and accessibility standards.

Throughout the development phase, a series of development URLs will be sent to the client, allowing them to see the progression from mark-up templates to functioning site.

Phase 3 - Testing

PSD will test the site in all major browsers on various Windows and Mac platforms. At this time, PSD will also jointly review the site and make any final revisions. This phase will not take long, but is critical to ensure a good hand-off and viewer experience.

Phase 4 - Delivery & Launch

Once the completed site has been approved and final payment received, all files will be moved over to the clients' server and made "live."

The final Photoshop files, a style guide, and the entire site as of launch, will be provided to the client via FTP for future use.

Project Details

Below, each of the items above is addressed in more detail outlining the optional solutions for the client. Quotes are listed for each option, so please note there is no final overall quote since this depends entirely on the options the client selects.

1 - Site Design

New Design from PSD

Ia - Logo Design

Mark-up

Once the site design has been approved, the site mark-up will begin. The site will be built using XHTML, CSS, and JavaScript where applicable. The site will follow all web and accessibility standards, ensuring it is XHTML compliant.

Following the XHTML/CSS mark-up, PSD will integrate the marked-up design into the CMS-driven site. See below for more regarding the CMS. Prior to launch, PSD will require SSH or FTP access to the client's server, and access to the client's database server (PSD can work with the client to get this information).



Site Testing

PSD will perform rigorous testing on the web-site. PSD will ensure that all pages are XHTML compliant, and that the look is consistent across all major browsers and OS's. At this time, we will also jointly review the site and make any final revisions. This phase will not take long, but is critical to ensure a good hand-off

2 - Content Management System (CMS)

A Content Management System allows a user/client to edit and maintain content on their website. There are many CMS options available – some are more affordable than others, and in some cases these can be extraordinarily expensive.

Wordpress Installation

Wordpress is in fact a blogging platform, but is used as a CMS for a number of sites. It is a very easy-to-use system with a number of great plug-ins and clean back-end code. I recommend Wordpress to most of my clients and would recommend it in this instance as the most affordable and easiest solution.

3 - Message board

Option 1: Simple Forum Wordpress Plug-In

4 - Newsletter/Mailing List

Hosting your own videos can be expensive and difficult to maintain if you aren't experienced with adding video content to a web site. It's recommended that you use one of the available free options below. Adding video to your site is as easy as copying and pasting a URL.

Option 1: Wordpress Mailing List Plug-In

WP has plug-ins for this and can be used within the CMS. I suggest using a plug-in called Wordpress Mailing List. Being fully complaint with the CAN-SPAM act, the Wordpress mailing list plug-in sends out mass newsletters from posts, newsletter templates or newly created messages without intruding your subscribers while giving them the ability to unsubscribe at any time if they needed to.

Option 2: Third Party Mailing List Service or Script

There are numerous third party mailing list options that we can easily bring into the site to provide this functionality.

A **1.5% monthly service charge** is payable on all overdue balances.

Hosting

PSD is not responsible for the hosting of the client's site, however, PSD is happy to recommend hosting services and help the client setup a hosting account with a third-party vendor.

Site Maintenance

If future site updates, edits or maintenance are required, PSD will gladly assist with these, but an additional charge will be invoiced on a per hour basis.
